University Accreditation Regulations
Detailed Regulations Related to the Scope and Nomination, and
Registration of Subcommittee Member Candidates

Article 1 Purpose

These Detailed Regulations set forth the necessary matters with respect to the scope and nomination and registration of candidates for members of the subcommittees and other bodies established under Article 13 of the Japan University Accreditation Association (“JUAA”) University Accreditation Regulations.

Article 2 Definitions

In these Regulations, a “Subcommittee Member” means a member of the University Review Subcommittee, a member of the Financial Affairs Review Subcommittee established under the University Accreditation Committee, or a member of any panel or other related body established under the Financial Affairs Review Subcommittee.

Article 3 Scope of Subcommittee Member Candidates

Of the Subcommittee Members specified in Article 13 of the Japan University Accreditation Association University Accreditation Regulations, those who may be appointed as subcommittee members other than those specifically designated therein shall be individuals who fall under any of the following categories:

- (1) Individuals who belong to a Full Member University of JUAA or a Related Organization and who have been nominated by the head of such Full Member University of JUAA or Related Organization and are registered with JUAA;
- (2) Individuals who belong to a Full Member University of JUAA or a Related Organization and have been nominated by the University Accreditation Committee as having deep insight into university education, research and other activities, and understanding the purpose of University Accreditation;
- (3) Individuals who formerly belonged to a university and who have been nominated by the University Accreditation Committee as having deep insight into university education, research and other activities and understanding the purpose of University Accreditation; or
- (4) Other experts nominated by the University Accreditation Committee.

Article 4 Nomination and Registration of Subcommittee Member Candidates

1. The nomination of Subcommittee Member candidates specified in Item (1) of the preceding article shall be made by the designated date based on the format specified by JUAA.
2. For the nomination in the preceding paragraph, the number of candidates that may be nominated for the University Review Subcommittee and the Financial Affairs Review Subcommittee (including any panels or other related bodies established under the Financial Affairs Review Subcommittee) shall be as separately determined by JUAA.
3. The registration period for Subcommittee Member candidates nominated in accordance with Paragraph 1 shall be two years; provided, however, that the registration may be renewed.
4. Full Member Universities of JUAA and Related Organizations may replace the candidates or additionally nominate candidates prescribed in Paragraph 2 during any period other than the period specified in Paragraph 1. In that case, the registration period shall end upon the expiration of the registration period specified in the preceding paragraph.
5. If a Full Member University of JUAA or a Related Organization withdraws the nomination of a Subcommittee Member candidate, it shall follow the procedures separately prescribed.

Article 5 Participation in Training Sessions

Persons registered under Article 3, Item (1), and those who fall under any of Items (2) through (4) of Article 3 and are scheduled to be appointed as Subcommittee Members may participate in training sessions held by JUAA.
