Article 1 Purpose

These Regulations set forth fees and related matters for third-party evaluations of educational, research, and other institutional activities in universities, conducted by the Japan University Accreditation Association (“JUAA”) pursuant to the provisions of Article 4, Paragraph 1, Item a, of the Articles of Incorporation of the Japan University Accreditation Association.

Article 2 Fees for Certified Evaluation and Accreditation

1. Fees for certified evaluation and accreditation shall be as set forth in Appendix 1 according to the type of evaluation; provided, however, that for universities or junior colleges that fall under any of the following items, the applicable divisions or departments shall not be included in the

calculation base for the fees:

- (1) If there is a faculty, graduate school, or department that has suspended student recruitment in the fiscal year prior to the application.
 - (2) If an evening or correspondence course is offered in conjunction with a daytime faculty, graduate school, or department in the same field.
2. Fees for Supplementary Review shall be set forth in Appendix 2 according to the type and content of evaluation; provided, however, that if a Supplementary Review is conducted without establishing a Supplementary Review Subcommittee, no fees shall be charged.

Article 3 Fees for Program Accreditation by Field of Study

Fees for program accreditation shall be set forth in Appendix 3.

Article 4 Fees for International Joint Accreditation

Fees for international joint accreditation shall be set forth in Appendix 4; provided, however, that travel, accommodation and other expenses incurred by evaluators in connection with the evaluation shall be borne by the university applying for the evaluation at actual cost.

Article 5 Accreditation Fees for Non-Full Member Universities or Junior Colleges

The fee for a university or junior college that is not a full member at the time of undergoing an evaluation under Article 2, Paragraph 1 shall be the amount specified in Article 2, Paragraph 1 plus an amount equivalent to five times the full membership fee that would apply if that university or junior college were a full member.

Article 6 Fees Related to Appeals

In the review of appeals, if hearings, site visits, or other measures are taken, the actual expenses incurred shall be charged.

Article 7 Payment Due Date

Fees and other charges shall be paid by the designated date.

Article 8 Refunds

Fees and other charges, once paid, shall not be refunded except under special circumstances.

Article 9 Revisions and Abolition

Any revisions to and abolition of these Regulations shall be made by the Board of Trustees.
